QUALIFICATIONS:

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior who resides in Freeborn Mower Electric Cooperative's (FMEC) service territory and receives electric service from FMEC. The student/parent must have an electric account at the time of the drawing.
- The awarded recipient must be enrolled as a full-time college student in the fall of 2026.
 Proof of enrollment must be submitted to FMEC before the funds are disbursed to the school. Information does not need to accompany the application. The funds will go directly to the college or university.
- Student's name and/or photographs may be published in the FMEC newsletter, on the website, and/or, on social media.

In the event the student is unable to fulfill his/her enrollment obligations, the award will be forfeited and returned to the cooperative.
