SCHOLARSHIP AWARD DETAILS:

- Two (2) students are awarded an all-expenses-paid trip to Washington, D.C. to participate in the Electric Youth Tour.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Applicant must be a junior or senior in high school and reside in the FMEC territory.
- Applicant must be a child or dependent of an FMEC member.
- If selected to advance in the process, the applicant must be available for an interview on Monday, March 16, 2026 (Beginning at 3:30 p.m.) Interviews will take place at Freeborn Mower Electric Cooperative.
- Applicant must be available for the Electric Tour to Washington, D.C., June 15 through June 20, 2026.
- The awarded delegate will be required to share their experience from the trip, with our FMEC Board of Directors at the following board meeting in June or July at the cooperative.

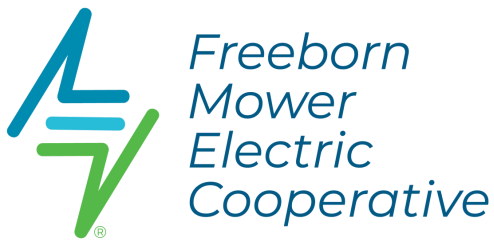

- A YouTube video link or essay response to the essay question(s). Multiple applicants cannot submit the same video. The video must be your original creation.
