 - A YouTube video link or essay response to the essay question (s). Multiple applicants cannot submit the same video. The video must be your original creation.

- **Final Selection** The final judging will be in the form of an interview process. (March 10, 2025, beginning at 3:30 p.m.) Two applicants will be awarded the Youth Tour Experience, and two will be selected for alternates.
- **Notification** All applicants will be notified of the outcome.
