



RESIDENTIAL ELECTRIC HEAT TAX EXEMPTION

IMPORTANT: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING

Electricity sold to residential consumers who use electricity as their primary source of heat (50% or more) are exempt from sales tax for the billing months of November, December, January, February, March and April. The usage months will be October through March. All electricity used through the same meter will also be exempt for the same six-month period.

Freeborn Mower Electric Cooperative (FMEC) requires a signed certificate stating that your primary source of heat (50% or more) is electricity. The purpose is 1) it notifies FMEC to remove the sales tax from your bill for the qualifying months, 2) in the event FMEC is audited by the Department of Revenue, FMEC would utilize the exemption certificate signed by you, as our authority to remove the sales tax. This is for the protection of the Cooperative. If Freeborn Mower Electric Cooperative were audited and it was found that the consumer’s bill was illegally exempted, it would be the responsibility of the individual consumer to pay any amount due plus penalties.

If you qualify and should be receiving the electric heat sales tax exemption, please complete this certificate and return to Freeborn Mower Electric Cooperative.
